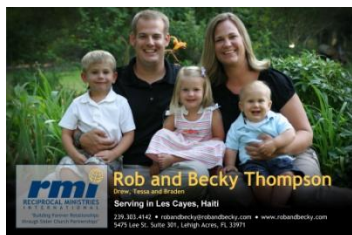

Career Ministry... There are currently full-time openings, both in Haiti as well as in the RMI International Office in Fort Myers, Florida.

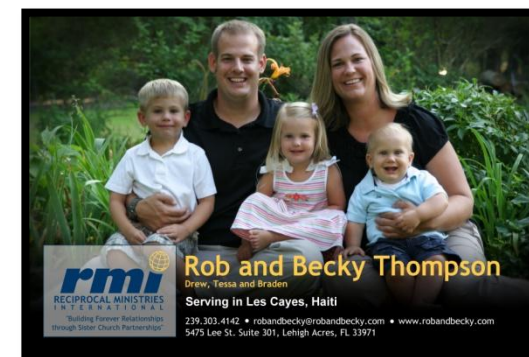
Become a Sister Church... Introduce your church to RMI, so your church can become a Sister Church to a church in Haiti. Contact the RMI office to request materials to present to your church.

Who is RMI?

Reciprocal Ministries International (RMI) develops reciprocal, cross-cultural, intimate, in-depth, ongoing, practical and spiritual Sister Church Partnerships between evangelical churches located throughout Haiti and all across the United States.

RMI's purpose is "to enable the Body of Christ to minister reciprocally through the Sister Church Program in order to assist Christ's Church towards maturity."

RMI is an evangelical, interdenominational, non-profit, faith-based mission agency, incorporated in 1988. It is supported by the gifts and prayers of churches, family and friends. We currently facilitate partnerships in Haiti. The vision of RMI is to see Christian volunteers ministering through the Sister Church Program, in the context of their local church, to Christians in a church of a different culture, and together with them, ministering to each other's community. Distinctives of RMI

We provide **comprehensive pre-trip training**, giving you background on the country, its culture, history and how-to tips on getting ready for your trip.

A **cross-cultural bridge team**, comprised of North American missionaries and national staff, is available on our fields and will accompany every team to their sister church, guiding and facilitating the partnership by providing transportation, lodging, interpretation, translation, and project accountability.

Visiting teams will spend **several days living with, fellowshiping and ministering** to and with their sister church to the surrounding community.

We work with established, evangelical, indigenous church associations.



What is the Sister Church Program?

Defined: Two churches from different cultures joining together in a dynamic sister church partnership to minister to one another and together to the world.

As these churches partner and visit together, boundaries are broken, individuals and churches are strengthened, and more effective ministry is accomplished, demonstrating and celebrating the unity of the Body of Christ through the Holy Spirit.

Collaborative ministry and projects (seminars, agriculture, building, medical, children and youth, sports, VBS, evangelism, etc.) flow from these relationships. We encourage small teams of 8-12 people from the US church to visit the foreign church once every 12-18 months. There is also opportunity for the Haitian Pastor and his wife to visit their US Sister Church.

What is Hope for Kidz?

Flowing directly out of the Sister Church Program, Hope for Kidz (HFK), is RMI's child sponsorship program. Individuals and groups can choose a child to sponsor in order to provide for them their school tuition, school entrance fee, school books, school uniforms, shoes, development of a Hot Lunch Program, a Christian education, and best of all, Hope!



HFK's goal is to meet the educational and physical needs of the many children who are unable to attend school due to severe economic conditions in their country.

Most of these schools are run by churches in the Sister Church Program. RMI provides a picture and biography of each sponsored child to each sponsor.
